### **Entrance Hymn:**

### **Tropar Tone 7:**

You were transfigured on the mountain, O Christ our God. \* revealing  
as much of Your glory to Your disciples as they could behold. \*  
Through the prayers of the Mother of God, \* let Your everlasting light  
also shine upon us sinners. \* O Giver of Light, glory be to You.

### **Kontakon Tone 7:**

Glory be: Now and ever:

You were transfigured on the mountain, O Christ our God, \* and Your disciples beheld as much as they could of Your glory, \* so that when they would see You crucified, \* they would understand that You suffered willingly; \* and they would preach to the world \* that You are truly the reflection of the Father.

### **Prokimenon Tone 4:**

How great are Your works, O Lord! In wisdom You have made them all!

*v. Bless the Lord, my soul! Lord God, how great You are!*

### **Alleluia Tone 8:**

*v. The heavens are Yours, the world is Yours.*

*v. Happy are the people, who acclaim such a King.*

*Instead of "Dostojno jest" we sing:*

O my soul / O my soul / extol the Lord / extol the Lord,  
transfigured on Mount Tabor.

You gave birth without blemish; for it was God Who came forth from your womb, appearing in the flesh upon the earth and dwelling among us. Therefore, O Mother of God, we all extol you.
