### Tropar (Tone 7):

Though the tomb had been sealed, \* from the tomb You arose, O Life and Christ our God. \*  
Though the door had been locked, \* You appeared among the disciples, O Resurrection of All;  
\* and thus You restored an upright spirit for us \* according to Your great mercy.

### Kontakion (Tone 8): Glory be...

Thomas placed his restless hand \* into Your life-giving side, O Christ our God; \*  
and since You entered, although the doors were locked, \* he cried out to You with the other  
Apostles: \* "You are my Lord and my God."

### Prokimenon (Tone 3):

Great is the Lord mighty in power;  
to His wisdom there is no limit.

*v. Praise the Lord for He is good. Sing to our God for He is loving. To Him our  
praise is due.*

### Tone 8:

Alleluia! Alleluia! Alleluia!

*v. Come, ring out your joy to the Lord; hail God Who is our savior.*

*v. Let us come before Him, giving thanks; with songs let us hail the Lord.*

### Communion Verse:
