Troparion (Tone 4):

We, Your servants, O Lord, are grateful * for Your benefits bestowed upon us. * And glorifying You, we praise and bless You, * we give thanks and we sing hymns to You. * Extolling Your loving kindness we cry out: * Glory be to You, our Benefactor and our Savior.

Kontakion (Tone 3):

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, now and ever, and forever. Amen.

O Master, You have freely granted Your benefits and gifts to us, * therefore, we have come to offer thanksgiving according to our ability. * O God Most Merciful, glory be to You.

Prokimenon (Tone 4):

I cry out to the Lord, Who has been my benefactor, I praise the name of the Lord in the highest.

v.Sing to the Lord a new song in the assembly of the faithful; sing to the Lord and give Him praise.

Alleluia:

v.When the afflicted man called out, the Lord heard him and saved him from all his distress.v. Many are the troubles of the just man, but out of them all the Lord delivers him.

Communion Verse:

Exult you just in the Lord, praise from the upright is fitting. Alleluia.
