Second Antiphon:

mount,**

save us who sing to You. Alleluia!

He brought them to His **holy** land,

to the mountain which His right **hand** had won.

**O Son, of God, Who was transfigured on the
mount...**

He chose Mount Sion **which** He loves,
He built His shrine like **the** heavens.

**O Son, of God, Who was transfigured on the

Third Antiphon:

Come, let us sing joyfully to the Lord,
let us shout with joy to God, our Savior.

save us who sing to You. Alleluia!**

Let us come into His presence with thanksgiving,
and let us joyfully sing psalms to Him.

For God is a great Lord,
and a great king over all the earth.

save us who sing to You. Alleluia!**

Entrance Hymn:

Send forth Your light and Your fidelity, O Lord; /
they shall lead me on / and bring me to Your holy
mountain.

Tropar Tone 7:

You were transfigured on the mountain, O Christ our God. * revealing as much of Your glory to Your disciples as they could behold. * Through the prayers of the Mother of God, * let Your everlasting light also shine upon us sinners. * O Giver of Light, glory be to You.

Kontakon Tone 7:

Glory be: Now and ever:

You were transfigured on the mountain, O Christ our God, * and Your disciples beheld as much as they could of Your glory, * so that when they would see You crucified, * they would understand that You suffered willingly; * and they would preach to the world * that You are truly the reflection of the Father.

Prokimenon Tone 4:

How great are Your works, O Lord! In wisdom
You have made them all!

*v. Bless the Lord, my soul! Lord God, how great
You are!*

Alleluia Tone 8:

*v. The heavens are Yours, the world is Yours.
v. Happy are the people, who acclaim such a
King.*

Instead of “Dostojno jest” we sing:

O my soul / O my soul / extol the Lord / extol the
Lord,
transfigured on Mount Tabor.

You gave birth without blemish; for it was God Who
came forth from your womb, appearing in the flesh upon
the earth and dwelling among us. Therefore, O Mother
of God, we all extol you.

Communion Verse:

Let us walk in the light of Your countenance, O
Lord.

Let us rejoice in Your name forever. Alleluia!
